SWEETEST OF SWEETS was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn, then closed fast and drew clear under urging. RHYTHM DOWN BELOW was slow early, raced inside on the far turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. WNDY'S TAN pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn, but lacked a late response. QUITE AN ANGEL set the pace with a clear lead, raced two wide on the far turn and tired late. CURLY HALO pressed the pace from along the inside through the far turn then flattened out. RED ROSALYN was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn but lacked a late rally. LA GLOIRE lacked speed, raced two wide on the second turn and showed little. THE STIGMATA was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn and faded thereafter. C C RED showed no speed, saved ground and was outrun.
