ACTSCLAMATION led the chase while out from the rail, moved to the front nearing the stretch, was clear entering the final furlong and was kept to urging. SKIM FOREVER was slow to settle, stayed inside around the turn, angled out for the drive and finished fast. GRUB FOR GOLD cleared then angled to the inside before going a furlong and weakened in the lane. TELL LAURA had her head turned when unprepared for the break, lagged early then made up ground late. DAMARISCOTTA made up some ground late without threatening. LYNDAA DEE raced three wide and lacked a closing. FANCY WAYS was outrun. SHELTER ME EARL was outrun.
