MAX'S RUNNER stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then drew off late under urging. ELECTRIC CITY was close up and inside on the turn, then made a late bid to be second best. SYDNEY SPEAKS set the pace while under pressure from the inside through the turn then drew clear in mid stretch but was outfinished. SMOKIN QUEENIE was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn, then made a mild bid late. SISTA was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. BEWITCHING BREEZE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn then faded. HERE'SHOWYADANCE saved ground but lacked a rally. TIMELY REWARD lacked speed and was outrun.
