Footnotes

NASTY NOOZIE stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn while being rated well, then drew clear late under mild encouragement. ZITRONE was close up and four wide on the first turn, then raced two wide and drew clear on the second turn but gave way late. MY ANGEL BECCA was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the top two. JUKE BOX JACKIE set the early pace, saved ground on the far turn then weakened. POWER OF GOLD was slow early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then made a mild bid late. HADLEY'S HARBOR was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn, then found her best stride late. RAVENESQUE was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn, then passed the tired ones. CLEAR CONCEPT was close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn, then faded in the drive. LIVING ALOHA was unhurried early, raced inside on the last turn, then failed to menace. PURIFIER pressed the pace early, raced two wide on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. ROBYNS TIME was close early, raced two wide on the last turn and faltered. PLUPERFECT was close up early, raced along the four

path on the second turn, was through after a half and outrun.
