HANSON HEIGHTS was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn then angled to the outside entering the stretch and drew off late while under encouragement. ADIRONDACK FOREST was never far back, raced two wide on the second turn then challenged late but was outfinished. LONELY WHISTLE was close up from the start, raced three wide on the far turn, then gained a late lead but gave way. AZULYEKIT raced in the middle of the pace, saved ground on the last turn and finished evenly. TEN MISSIONS was unhurried early, saved ground and gained a clear lead on the last turn, then faded in the drive. FORTUNATE RUN pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide on the second turn, then faltered late. PLEASE WAIT lacked speed, saved ground on the far turn, then passed one late. CHEROKEE ROMANCE set the pace from the start with a clear lead, raced inside on the second turn then faltered and was outrun late.
