MON CHOU was caught in tight between rivals on the backstretch, came out four wide for room midway on the final turn, bid outside into the final furlong and ran clear late. DREAMLESS moved clear early, stayed out from the rail and gave way grudgingly. ALL ABOUT ALEX wasn't far back inside, came out two wide between rivals while moving on the final turn, angled out further in the stretch but couldn't gain. CORTONA was bumped back leaving the gate then was unhurried, rallied two wide between rivals into the stretch but couldn't gain late. EASTER SERVICE trailed early then made a late run outside. MS COLENZO settled inside, advanced into the stretch but failed to sustain. MOON MUSIC came out three wide while moving on the final turn then tired. SKIPPYS GATOR was outrun. SCARLET'S NUMBER tired outside. WONDERWONDERWHY had position two wide into the far turn then stopped and was eased up late. KALIA came in leaving the gate then was outrun and stopped.
