MISS MAISY showed speed, moved two wide to the front midway on the turn and widened under urging. PEAKABOO I C U cleared early, stayed inside and gave way. NUMBER UNO LADY had position inside but lacked a rally. STINGALING lagged after a slow break then rallied the rail into the stretch and finished willingly. GRIZZLY GIRL was slow early, raced two wide between rivals into the stretch, angled to the rail and made up ground late. NEW IDENTITY showed speed outside then tired. LITTLE WAYS was in close quarters between rivals on the backstretch then tired. BILLY CALLINGHONEY steadied along the rail early on the backstretch and failed to menace. DUAL POWER came wide into the stretch and tired. FIRM DOLLAR was outrun.
