**Footnotes**

SHOCK APPEAL stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then rallied late and drew off while under urging. BUNNY BLIZZARD vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, entered into a long drive then gave way. ROCKIN RUBY HILLS vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, dueled through the lane then weakened late. ROYAL DAWN was close up from the start, raced along the three path through the turn then rallied mildly in the stretch. DOWNRIGHT JOYOUS was never far back, raced four wide on the turn and tired in the drive. ELVI'S ELPIDA vied for the early lead, raced inside on the turn then weakened in the lane. GYPSY TRAVELER was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn and lacked a rally. BENNY STAY HOME showed early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then faded in the drive. VINOTECA lacked speed, saved ground on the turn, then passed one in the stretch. LADY JUNIOR lacked speed, raced along the three path on the turn and was outrun.
