Footnotes

EVERYONE stalked the pace from along the inside on the turn, angled to the outside and rallied to be up in the final strides. WET 'N WILD CAT pressed the pace from the four path and contended on the turn, then gained a late lead but was outfinished at the wire. EXPOSED IMAGE was slow early, raced two wide through the turn, then closed ground willingly. FORT MIFFLIN pressed the early pace, raced four wide on the turn and reached contention, then weakened in the stretch. FOREST HILLS DR prompted the early pace, raced two wide on the turn and contended, then lacked a late response. JOHN PAT was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. KASH KOW KAZ set the pace from along the inside, was headed on the turn then faded in the lane. MAGGIES DINER was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. IMPULSE PURCHASE lacked speed, raced along the two path on the turn while trailing the field.
