BEENIE was slow early, raced three wide through the turn, then closed ground fast from the outside. SPIKEAVELLIAN was close up from the start, raced three wide on the turn and evenly throughout. SNOW HILL was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. DANTASTIC was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a rally late. BILLY BELMONT stalked the pace from the start, raced two wide on the turn then faded late. MONEY ISSUES was void of early speed, raced inside through the turn and was never a factor. KAPER LAKE raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace. LONG ISLAND LOUIE set the pace from the start, held a clear lead while saving ground through the turn, then faltered in the stretch. CASE NOTES lacked speed, was very wide on the turn and was outrun. PRICELESS VIEW raced inside to the turn and broke down.
