CALL YOU IN TEN bided his time inside rivals, split the leaders leaving the final jump to quickly open a clear lead and held under brisk urging. MISS CROWN was unhurried early, rallied outside around the final turn to reach contention nearing the final jump but couldn't gain on the winner. EASY RED was unhurried while outside in the second flight, moved to vie over the seventh jump, opened a short lead nearing the final straight then flattened out. MOON DOLLY (GB) was unhurried inside, moved outside to vie into the seventh jump then tired in the lane. HOPE FOR US ALL was unhurried, was caught wide while moving around the third turn then tired. SO AMAZING (IRE) stayed inside and failed to menace. SPARKLED moved to vie inside on the seventh jump and faded in the drive. SALUDA SAM lagged early, began a run on the third turn, bobbled over the seventh jump then was eased. MOVING VIOLATION moved to a long lead after the second jump, stopped after the sixth jump and was eased.
