SILVER PRISM took turns on the front end while saving ground, moved clear into the stretch and held. OPERA HEROINE was unhurried inside, rallied into the stretch, angled out late and gained to the end. ECHT was unhurried inside, came out three wide on the final turn while moving but failed to sustain her bid. DOMESTIC BLISS began a run into the far turn, came out wide on the far turn while drawing closer then lacked a further response. FORCE EIGHT angled outside on the backstretch, was three wide around the final turn and made up ground late. DAME MARGOT weakened two wide. FIX YOU dueled outside the winner to the stretch then tired. BILLIE B QUICK was outrun. PEACHES MY DEAR was outrun. NOBLE MAZ angled to the inside while in early position then stopped.
