GATTO NERO pressed outside early, angled to the rail midway on the turn, vied into the final furlong, edged clear and held under urging. QUIET TIARA moved clear early on the backstretch, stayed out from the rail and couldn't stay with the winner. MARIPOSA ROSA was never far back, moved to vie three wide on the turn but lacked a strong closing. GOOD SONG was slo early, raced wide into the stretch and finished willingly outside. SILVER WAVE raced between rivals and lacked a closing. LIGHTNIN LIZZIE stayed along the rail around the turn and failed to menace. REPORT BACK showed speed inside to the turn then tired. FLUXO DE CAIXA was outrun. NICTATE broke slowly and fell far back.
