Footnotes

SIR CAPITULATION set the pace from the start, raced two wide through the turn and drew off to finished handily. METRO MAN was slow early, raced four wide on the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. MARIO'S MIRACLE was close up early, raced three wide through the turn then weakened in the lane. CAMARILLO was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn, then passed the tired ones. QUARTERS pressed the early pace, raced inside on the turn and faded in mid stretch. KEY TO BROOKLYN showed brief speed, was three wide through the turn then flattened out.
