KAN N KLEAR was unhurried inside, began a run after a half, angled out through the lane and was along in time. HAZELSHEARTSTRINGS cleared soon after the break, stayed inside, remained clear for over a mile but couldn't last. LOVELY SONYA DOR stayed out from the rail while unhurried, then finished gamely. SHARIK moved up outside early, remained out from the rail while chasing then weakened. PATIENCE OF JOB steadied two wide between rivals entering the far turn, raced three wide into the stretch and outfinished the others. MARK UP TINY wasn't far back two wide early then stopped. FAVORED LADY steadied along the rail entering the far turn and failed to menace. PRICELESS PRINCESS wasn't far back early, steadied in tight along the rail entering the far turn then stopped. TREZ was finished early.
