EDITORS RANSOM was close up and inside on the last turn, then angled outward and contended in mid stretch and drew off under urging. THEONEILOVE was never far back, raced three wide on the last turn, then contended late to be second best. THE COLOR RED was close up from the start, contended on the last turn, then weakened late. PLEASANT HONOREE set the pace early, was headed on the backstretch and dueled to mid stretch then gave way. SIDEWALKING was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. GHOSTLY SPIRIT was close up early, saved ground and contended through the last turn then tired. GREAT BRIDGE saved ground but was not a threat. CHANGEINTHE COURSE failed to menace. BIDDY'S GAP pressed the pace from the two path to the far turn then flattened out.
