CHAPEL OF LOVE was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late and finished second best. STORM RISING was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. WILD REPENT vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened late. SUNDAY BLITZ pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, then lacked a late response. CAMPEONE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then found his best stride late. STOLEN PARCEL vied for the lead from the three path through the turn then faded. POLISH SMILE was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH showed good early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then tired from early efforts. CALLITMYWAY vied for the lead from the two path on the the turn, then flattened out late. PLEASURE BOAT was outrun.
