MR. HOT STUFF was taken back in the early going, began to advance nearing the final turn and prevailed after a stiff drive. ROMAN GLORY (IRE) was never far back, moved clear on the final turn then gave way. EASY RED was unhurried, rallied closer into the stretch but couldn't gain. AIR MAGGY was unhurried early then made up ground too late. SLANEY ROCK (IRE) was steadied over the sixth jump to avoid the fallen horses, moved closer nearing the final turn then flattened out. SALUDA SAM settled, was sent closer into the final turn then stumbled over the final jump and unseated his rider. FOG ISLAND drew out to a clear early early then left the course before the final jump and was eased. PARKER'S PROJECT fell over the fallen horse leaving the sixth jump. GRANTOR fell over the sixth jump.
