HOUND set the pace from the start, held a clear lead through the last turn, then was headed late and prevailed. READY OR NOT was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn, then reached contention late and just missed. D. J.'S HERO was close up from the start, raced along the inside through the second turn, then lacked a late response. DANCIN' DIXIE CAT pressed the pace from the inside through the far turn then weakened in the stretch. SOCIAL CODE was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn then made a mild bid. ROYAL CLASH was close up early, then faded on the far turn. SPICY VOW showed little. NORTHEASTERN lacked speed, saved ground on then second turn and was outrun.
