IGOR set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and held well under urging. SPIKEAVELLIAN was unhurried early, raced two wide on the far turn, then closed willingly and just missed. INODINO pressed the pace from along the inside through the second turn then weakened. SUVOROV was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. ROYAL STYLIST saved ground but lacked a rally. LAYTON was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn then faded. WALRONDS broke slowly, then saved ground to the far turn, angled outward on that turn and showed little. DANCE PRO lacked speed and showed little. CALVIN K was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
