Footnotes

RED ARMY vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then drew clear in mid stretch and held at the wire. FOREST HILLS DR stalked the pace from the four path through the turn, then made a late bid and was second best. BELIEVE IN YOU raced close up from the start and was two wide through the turn, then lacked a rally. POPPYS LIL LION vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. CHASE THE UNKNOWN also vied for the lead, raced inside on the turn then faded late. DICEMAN was slow early, raced inside on the turn and not a threat. SOLD MY SOUL vied for the lead early, raced along the three path on the turn then faded in the stretch. STAYINTHEGAME lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn, then passed one late. GETTEM READY EDDIE showed brief speed, raced inside on the turn, then tired and was outrun.
