RUNAWAY SUZANNA was unhurried early while saving ground, moved on the second turn while angling three wide, then rallied late and prevailed at the wire. SECRET LONGING was close up and well rated, raced two wide through the second turn, made a late charge but was outfinished. OVER SPICED vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the second turn, then gained command late but was outfinished. DREAM LOUISE was slow early, raced two wide through the last turn, then found her best stride late. TOUCH THE BIRDS vied for the lead from the two path through the far turn, then gave way in the stretch. GREY GODDESS was close up early, raced inside on the second turn, then lacked a late response. SIMPLE SONGS vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the last turn, then faltered in the stretch.
