COLONEL RUTLEDGE was slow to settle, raced two wide between horses around the turn, angled out in early stretch and reached the front late. COOPER JUNIOR was caught in tight along the rail around the turn, came out for the drive, took over before a half but couldn't last. OFFICIAL AFFAIR raced three wide between horses into the stretch, drifted into EARLSWOOD PETE and lacked a rally. EARLSWOOD PETE moved up four wide on the turn then was bumped in the drive and hung. CHANNINGSTOWN swung wide into the stretch but lacked a strong closing. SPRIDAL broke slowly then made up some ground. UNSUAL MANNER took over soon after the break, angled to the rail on the turn and tired. PETCH was outrun inside. HE'S APPEALING was no factor. CANDY GAMES was outrun. GAARA showed speed two wide for less than a half.
