WHIRLEY SHIRLEY stalked the pace from the two path through the last turn, then rallied late and as up in the final strides. FIVE CARAT KELLY vied for the early lead, raced two wide through the second turn, then gained a late lead but was outfinished. BLOWING A HOOLIE was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. IM NOT YOUR FRIEND was unhurried early, saved ground on the far turn, then made a mild bid late. MOUNTIAN GAL vied for the lead from along the inside, drew off on the far turn then flattened out late. SEEKING THE CITI was void of early speed, raced three wide on the last turn and failed to menace. SNICKER SOCKS was slow early, raced along the inside on the second turn and was not a threat. QUARRY TREMOR was through early, raced two wide on the far turn and was outrun.
