JOHNNYJIMMYCHOO vied for the lead from the two path, drew clear on the last turn and finished under steady urging. TRUMATCH was close up and two wide through the second turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. DEVIL'S BREW vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. SNOBBY SCAMP was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn, advanced steadily in a good effort. GRANDAD BUD was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then tired in the stretch. ROCK BRANCH was outrun through the second turn while saving ground, then angled outward and found his best stride late. S W AIDAN raced two wide on the far turn and failed to menace. DESERT PEPPER was through early, raced along the inside on the far turn and was never a factor. QUIET ECHO vied for the lead from along the inside, then flattened out in the stretch. EXCEPTIONAL HONOR raced along the inside on the second turn and was outrun.
