Footnotes

ONE AND ONLY YOU stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. RAPID AUDITION was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn, then closed fast and just missed. SHULANA pressed the pace from the three path on the second turn and finished evenly. DANCE WINNER was slow early, raced two wide on the second turn, then made a late bid. WAY OUT VERDICT saved ground and rallied mildly. SECRET MISS vied for the lead from the inside through the second turn, drew clear in the stretch but gave way late. DEER CREEK LADY was void of early speed, raced two wide on the far turn, then passed tiring rivals. VOODOO VALENTINE vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn, then faded in the stretch. SISTER SUZIE SLEW was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn and faltered. GABBY DANCER was in tight nearing the 3/8 pole, then angled out on the second turn but lacked a rally. ANDES PRIDE was three wide on the second turn and not a factor. SHEZA PRINCESS was close up early, raced four wide on the second turn and was outrun.
