ZOARES LAND dueled inside, moved clear in early stretch and held late. MIRACLE SHOT lagged early, moved quickly between horses on the backstretch to gain position, came three wide into the stretch, was bumped near the final furlong then closed a gap too late. IM A TIGGER TOO dueled outside the winner to the stretch then bore out and weakened. AWESOME RUBIANO raced three wide around the final turn and lacked a rally. CHERCHUESE D'OR was caught wide around both turns, advanced on the final turn then tired. J TRAIN tired. AJUSTABULL tired inside. AMARILLO SKY raced three wide with the early pace then stopped. WALLEY'S WAY was outrun.
