GOLDEN EXPRESS vied for the lead from the start and along the inside through the far turn, then drew off late and just lasted while under steady encouragement. FO FO FO was unhurried early, raced along the inside through the last turn, angled outward in the stretch and closed ground willingly. WITH SPRINKLES was slow early, raced two wide on the second turn then made a late bid. SISTERINLAW was close up from the start, raced along the inside through the last turn then lacked a rally. PRINCESS MAGOGO vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide through the second turn then weakened late. EMPANGENI pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. ANNE'S TUITION was void of early speed, raced three wide on the last turn, then failed to menace. FRONT STREET was close up early, raced along the inside through the far turn then faded. FOREVER DIVA was also close up early, raced along the two path on the far turn and faltered in the lane. NO SAX raced three wide on the last turn and was never a threat. LIVING ALOHA saved ground and trailed the field.
