**Footnotes**

SAVED BY THE MOON was unhurried inside, moved three wide to a clear lead approaching the stretch and was kept to a drive. KINDA KINDA had early position inside, came out three wide nearing the stretch but lacked a strong closing. DEVILENA ducked in sharply leaving the gate, made the pace inside to the end of the backstretch then weakened. SHADY MADAM pressed three wide, moved to a short lead early on the far turn then tired. MECKE'S SWEETHEART was shuffled back at the break then was unhurried and made up some ground between rivals. HOPPING SEATTLE trailed early then failed to menace with a mild late run. SUGAR SHARK was outrun. BELLAMY CAY wasn't far back outside early then stopped. SOUTH SEA PEARL was shuffled back at the break, moved up outside early then stopped. PURE HEAT showed speed two wide into the far turn then stopped and was eased up.
