GAMBINE ROAD was slow early, rallied four wide between horses into the stretch, closed outside and was along in time. PAUL'S FINAL ONE was unhurried, rallied four wide around the turn, drew even on the front in deep stretch but couldn't last. WORKZONE dueled two wide and gave way late. OCTORARO KID was caught in tight along the rail on the backstretch and turn then made up some ground. JZ'SLOVEFORHEROSE was caught in tight behind horses on the backstretch, raced two wide into the stretch then made up ground late. CALLAWASSE was slow from the gate, raced five wide around the turn and made up some ground. MOORESTOWN STORM had position two wide between horses to the stretch then weakened. WELCHMAN HALL made the early pace inside then stopped. NAJRIN was finished early.
