TENTHSTREET pressed the pace from the start, raced along the two path on the turn, the was no match for the winner in the drive and held place. SAND DEVIL was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the turn, then made a late bid. THEBRITISHRCOMING was close early, raced along the three path on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. MICK JAZZER was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a rally. VIM was hustled along early, raced inside on the turn and showed little throughout. OPORTUNO lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and was outrun.
