Footnotes

RAMESES THE GREAT was unhurried inside, came out two wide between horses while beginning to move on the final turn, swung wide into the stretch then closed outside and was along in time. AL AMIR stayed out from the rail once clear before going a quarter, bore out sharply under left hand whip entering the final furlong and couldn't last. GOGOLEGO was unhurried, raced three wide around the final turn and finished fast inside the winner. YANKEE PILOT raced two wide in the second flight while close to the early leader but lacked a closing response. PATTON'S TERMS settled early, raced two wide between horses around the final turn and gained mildly through the lane. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) was unhurried, advanced the rail around the final turn, drifted out sharply and was steadied entering the final furlong then again through late stretch. CAPE GIRARDEAU lagged early then swung wide into the stretch with a late run. ROYAL JIN stayed inside and lacked a strong closing. SWINGMAN had position in the three path around the final turn then tired. POWER ONE stopped inside. RAVENTRONIC was finished early.
