Footnotes

NO ATTRACTION showed speed from the outset, dueled two wide around the turn and proved narrowly best after a prolonged drive. ROVING moved to duel inside the winner but wasn't quite enough in a game effort. SEVENISTHENUMBER was unhurried, swung wide into the stretch, had to be straightened away while lugging in and finished fast outside. P FORTY WARHAWK wasn't far back two wide to the stretch then gained late between horses. OMRICON was slow to settle, raced two wide between horses into the stretch and finished with good energy. DISTINCT BY DESIGN had early position outside, fell back on the turn and lacked a strong closing. ALLEGHENY FOG angled through tight quarters early on the backstretch to get to the rail and made up some ground. COULDBEAGHOSTRIDER was slow leaving the gate, trailed to the stretch then made up some ground. PEAT BAY angled to the inside on the turn then tired. SHOCKRAHAWN was very slow from the gate then was outrun.
