Footnotes

ALICANTINO was unhurried inside, began a run into the far turn, swung out entering the stretch, came in and bumped with PEAT BAY a couple of times in early stretch and prevailed after a long drive. PEAT BAY cleared soon after the break, stayed inside, came out and bumped with the winner through the lane and continued with good courage once displaced. WINGO STAR settled, made a run along the rail around the final turn to get closer in early stretch but lacked a further response. DOMESTIC CIRCLE stayed out from the rail while chasing the early leader to the stretch then weakened. SPINNING OUT was unhurried following a slow break, made a run two wide between horses around the final turn and continued willingly. S W AIDAN had position well out from the inside and weakened. KHABIBULIN was outrun two wide. CAPTAIN SPITLER was outrun three wide. ROYAL JIN wasn't far back outside early, angled to the rail nearing the far turn then tired. FIVE GUNS WEST was outrun.
