**Footnotes**

RUN PATTY RUN made all the pace from along the rail and held stubbornly. GIRL WANDO pressured two wide but wasn't enough in a game effort. MARCHING HOME had position inside throughout, awaited room on the final turn then weakened in the lane. SPEEDWAY MONKEY was unhurried early, made a run well out from the rail around the final turn but couldn't gain through the lane. SHE'S STARSTRUCK was unhurried inside to the stretch then angled out through the lane while closing well. PASS OR PLAY came out from the rail while moving on the final turn and gained mildly to the end. TROPICAL JETSET was unhurried inside, came out between rivals in early stretch but lacked a strong closing. MISS STAUDER bore out badly through the lane. AWESOME CAROLINE was steadied in tight through the early going then was outrun. ZAMITA trailed.
