TODAY'S TREASURE showed speed outside, took over early on the backstretch, remained out from the rail once clear on the final turn and held under steady urging. ASPETUCK HILL was caught in tight along the rail on the first turn, came out between rivals and was in tight again early on the backstretch, stayed well out from the rail around the final turn while chasing then weakened. COUNTRY GREEN wasn't far back outside, raced well out from the rail around the final turn then weakened. SUGAR SHARK was slow to settle, raced three wide around the final turn and continued evenly through the lane. SPEEDY SWEETY wasn't far back two wide for about three quarters then tired. READ RICHIES NOTES was outrun outside. LOVELY SONYA DOR took command at once, angled close to the rail soon after then stopped after five furlongs.
