Footnotes

KNOCKINELDER showed speed, took over midway on the backstretch, stayed inside around the turn and widened after a half under urging. JUST CHRISTINA broke sharply to make the early pace outside the winner then couldn't keep up after a half. NASHI was caught in tight along the rail into the turn, swung out three wide entering the stretch and continued evenly. THREETIMESAWonder had position, was caught in tight along the rail approaching the lane, swung out between rivals and weakened. ONLY ME angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a closing. BOLD MANEUVER wasn't far back three wide, was forced wide into the stretch and weakened. HUMBLE SONG was forced widest into the stretch and weakened.
