SECOND CITY vied for the early lead from the two path, then drew clear on the turn and finished under urging. INCOMPREHENSIBLE vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the turn, then was no match for the winner in the stretch. FOREIGN REVIEW pressed the pace early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. DUBONNET RED was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a rally. CU SOONERTHANLATER was unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn and was not a threat. JACUMBA lacked speed, raced inside through the turn and showed little. RED SOLO was through after a half, raced two wide on the turn then was outrun.
