### Footnotes

SLIPCOVER was close up and two wide through the turn, then angled outward and rallied to draw off while being ridden out to the wire. LADY SPITFIRE pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, reached contention late then was outfinished. IMPULSE BUYER vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, entered into a long drive then gave way. APPARENT DANGER vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. ONE THOUSAND SHIPS was slow early, raced along the three path through the turn, then found her best stride late. MISSROYALLITE vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then faded in the stretch. T. T. TANGO was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. ART SERIES was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn and was not a factor. LIL EVILE AISLE lacked speed, raced inside on the turn, then passed the tired ones. SHE'S PARADISE vied for the early lead, raced four wide on the turn, then faltered late. REAL SHENANIGANS showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn, then flattened out. SOUTHERN PARFAIT was through early, raced three wide on the turn and was outrun.
