BERGER LANE was never far back, moved four wide to command midway on the turn and held stubbornly. WISE THINKING moved to the front before going a furlong and continued with good courage to the end. MATISSE was slow to settle, raced wide into the stretch and made up some ground outside. MOLTEN STEEL was bumped repeatedly leaving the gate, moved up outside early and lacked a rally. TONY'S AWARD was slow to settle then made a late run outside. THE ROOFER came out into MOLTEN STEEL at the break moved up inside early and failed to menace. HULAACON was hustled to keep up early, raced three wide around the turn and tired. JUST ASK ROBERT raced two wide with the pace for about a half then tired. NICE TURN ducked out leaving the gate then was outrun.
