EMILY WILD vied for the lead from along the inside into the turn, then drew clear and finished under urging. K C'S CHARM pressed the pace from along the inside on the turn, angled outward and finished evenly. BENNINGTON raced three wide on the turn and made a mild rally. LITTLE MISS LEAP was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn and was not a factor. MINT' LUCK stalked the pace from the three path into the turn, then faded in the drive. JUDGE BRANDY vied for the lead from the two path on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch. FLAG ANGEL lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn and trailed the field.
