### Footnotes

BOOT THE BOSS stalked outside, was caught four wide around the turn and drove clear through the final sixteenth. BLACKBERRY ROAD was slow to settle, stayed inside to the stretch, angled outside and gained to the end. LOVE TREASURES waited inside for room behind the early leaders, was sent through to the front midway on the turn then flattened out. HIT A HOMER was bumped at the break, moved to stalk three wide to the stretch and weakened. BABY KING stayed just out from the rail with the early lead then tired. STRAIGHT THUNDER came in sharply and fell back leaving the gate and was outrun.
