HELPING HAND was rated in good position, moved two wide to command midway on the turn then drew out under urging. COULDBEAGHOSTRIDER was bumped after the break then was unhurried, stayed close to the inside and made up some ground. SOLITARY SUNSHINE moved clear midway on the backstretch, stayed inside and tired. DISTINCT BY DESIGN wasn't far back to the stretch while racing well out from the rail then tired. GRANDMAS PIANO MAN was bumped hard early on the turn, raced three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. TUSCANY'S PROSPECT was bumped leaving the gate, angled to the inside and failed to menace. JOHN PAT showed speed to the turn, bore out and stopped. SMALL GIANT was bumped early on the turn then was eased up late while outrun. OUR HAE left stirrup strap broke at the break then was eased.
