DEVIL'S BREW angled to the inside while not far back early, awaited room behind the leaders on the backstretch and around the final turn, came out for the drive and was going away late. TEPOX took command at once, angled to the inside and couldn't withstand the winner. HEYWOODS had position three wide, was carried wide into the stretch and weakened. AGONISTIC wasn't far back, made a run four wide into the far turn, was carried wide into the stretch and continued evenly. TRUMATCH was slow to settle, stayed inside around the final turn, angled out in early stretch and made up some ground. ENFORCER was slow early, stayed inside around the final turn and lacked a closing. DUCHMASTER duelled two wide, ran out entering the stretch and tired. SHARP HEART was no factor. HEY CHARLIE was outrun. RONDAS MY MOM showed speed briefly.
