WAWASET PARK settled, steadied behind horses into the turn, swung wide into the stretch and ran clear from the outside through the final yards. SCOTCHONHEROCKS took command at once, stayed inside, was clear past midstretch but gave way. PATTYSBUDDY chased while out from the rail but lacked a rally. COMMUNICATOR was slow from the gate then moved up inside early, came well out from the rail nearing the stretch, moved closer in early stretch but lacked a further response. FOR ALL WHO CONGA was unhurried, came out wide nearing the stretch and lacked a rally. TALEITLIKEITAIN'T was close up between horses early then tired. J. PA showed speed outside then tired.
