Footnotes

SIR CAPITULATION took over from the outside before going a furlong, stayed well out from the rail once clear on the turn and was under intermittent urging through the lane. BACK ALLEY TALES had early position outside, fell back three wide on the turn then regained some ground through the lane. COCO POINT was caught in tight along the rail on the backstretch, came out between horses for room while rallying into the turn but lacked a strong closing response. JUSTIN M showed speed between horses, angled to the inside on the turn and weakened. HE'S APPEALING showed speed inside then stopped. ONYX angled to the inside then stopped.
