Footnotes

GEE DUBYA BEE was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn, then rallied late and drew off under steady encouragement. BULLFEATHERS was close up and two wide on the last turn, gained command then was outfinished late. GALLASLAD was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn then made a late bid. VICTORIAN KNIGHT was void of early speed, raced two wide on the last turn then rallied late. NIGHTSCAPE failed to menace. EASY PASS LANE saved ground on the second turn and was not a factor. WILD POKER pressed the pace from the two path then weakened on the second turn. MR MEDIEVAL lacked speed and showed little. MEMORIAL STORM set the pace with a clear lead, weakened on the far turn, then was outrun in the stretch.
