OOPERS HERE moved to the front from the inside midway on the backstretch and held stubbornly. IL DIVO moved up inside early, came out three wide midway on the turn, vied outside the winner into the final furlong, drifted late and wasn't enough. CHANCE AND A HALF pressed the winner two wide to the stretch then weakened. ON TIME SOMETIME was slow to find best stride. CHEROKEE EMPIRE stayed out from the rail and lacked a rally. BACK ALLEY TALES lagged following a slow break then made up some ground. HIGH SUCCESS was outrun. JOEL'S TOUCH was outrun. BALIAN broke sharply to make the early pace then stopped.
