**Footnotes**

POWER OF GOLD was caught in tight quarters while not far back between rivals on the backstretch, raced two wide around the final turn, vied outside through the lane, took over past midstretch while trying to lug in and held. SHEPPARD'S PIE was unhurried while not far back two wide between rivals, was caught in tight quarters while trying to rally between rivals through the lane and finished with good courage. An objection by Cintron against the winner was not allowed. ELEGANT HEART took command at once, made the pace out from the rail into late stretch then gave way. DEFEET R FLEET was slow early, angled to the rail entering the far turn, came out between rivals for the drive and finished willingly. WHERE'S ROSIE B steadied in tight along the inside nearing the first turn, stayed along the rail around the final turn then steadied in tight entering the final furlong and continued evenly to finish in a dead heat for fifth. ADANNA was caught wide around the first turn while unhurried then made a belated run outside to finish even for fifth. HAZ THE BEAT moved inside the early leader on the backstretch then weakened in the lane. WITTY MISS pressed outside the early leader into the far turn then weakened. SISTERINLAW steadied along the rail entering the fear turn, came out and failed to menace. DANCINWITHNOSHUZ raced three wide around the first turn then tired.
