Footnotes

RED PETE stalked three wide from the outset, moved clear in midstretch and held under urging. BRAULIO was taken in hand following an alert break, angled out nearing the stretch while moving and finished with good energy outside. ROCKIN IN DIXIE was a step slow from the gate then was sent up to vie inside the early leader, opened a short lead into the turn then weakened through the final sixteenth. PLEASURE BOAT was slow early, came well out into the track on the turn and made up some ground. I AM NOT WHO I WAS fell back after the break, lagged inside and failed to menace. COCO POINT made the early pace between horses to the turn then stopped.
